Infosheet

Within the available resources, Support Art and Research administrates and provides temporary work- and research spaces for project employees and doctoral students. For students in the scientific doctoral programmes, the dissertation agreement must already be concluded. VZA7 room 046 and PSK/GCP room 801 are considered suitable for **focused and silent research**, providing mainly standard (desk-) workplaces. VZA7 room 045 provides both standard workplaces and facilities for **collaborative research and exchange**.

Support Art and Research

Type of usage

Please follow the **respective guidelines** concerning the type of work (e.g., silent or collaborative) and be considerate to the people you share the space with, including mindful noise management, appropriate use of the storage spaces, cleaning up after yourself, or reasonable time of desk occupation (e.g., leaving notes stating the time of your absence). It is recommended to **choose the space according to your respective way of working**, instead of one consistent workplace.

Please note that a **clear desk care plan** applies, meaning that each desk needs to be cleared of all personal belongings upon leaving. Furthermore, all rooms are considered **self-governed co-working spaces** used with **personal and collective responsibility** among all users.

Access

There must be a connection to a research project or doctoral programme. Prospective users should send an email to projektsupport@uni-ak.ac.at containing the following **information**: Name, email, phone number, research project or doctoral program, and duration of use. Students in the **scientific doctoral programmes** must have already concluded their **dissertation agreement** and attach the form to their request.

You will then be put on the key list and can fetch the key from the **portier** at Vordere Zollamtsstraße 7 (for rooms 045 and 046) and Georg-Coch-Platz 2 (for room 801). If other people are in the room that day, the door might already be open. **Please hand the key back in to the portier** every time you are the last person to leave.
